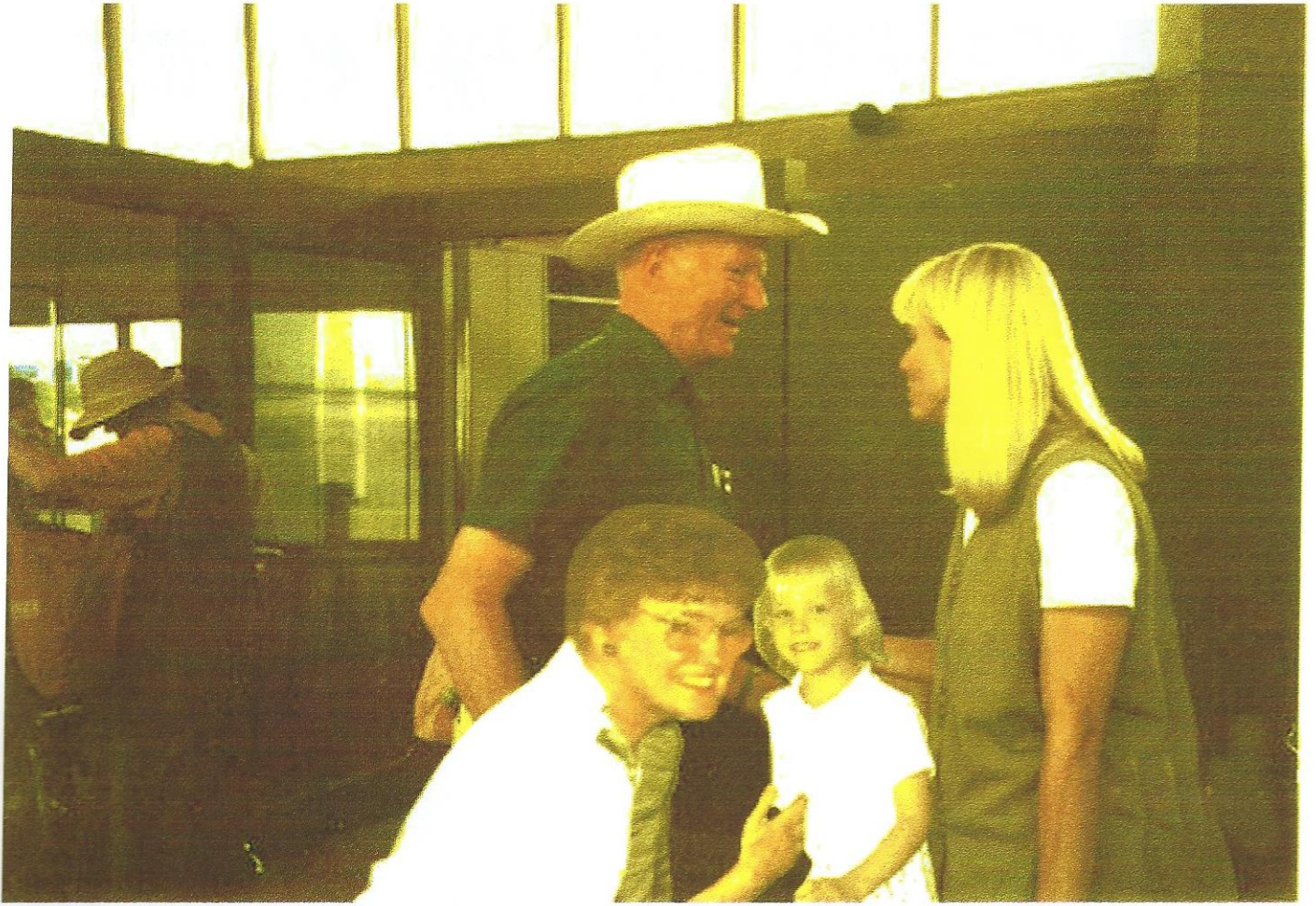

We fly on a big jet plane.



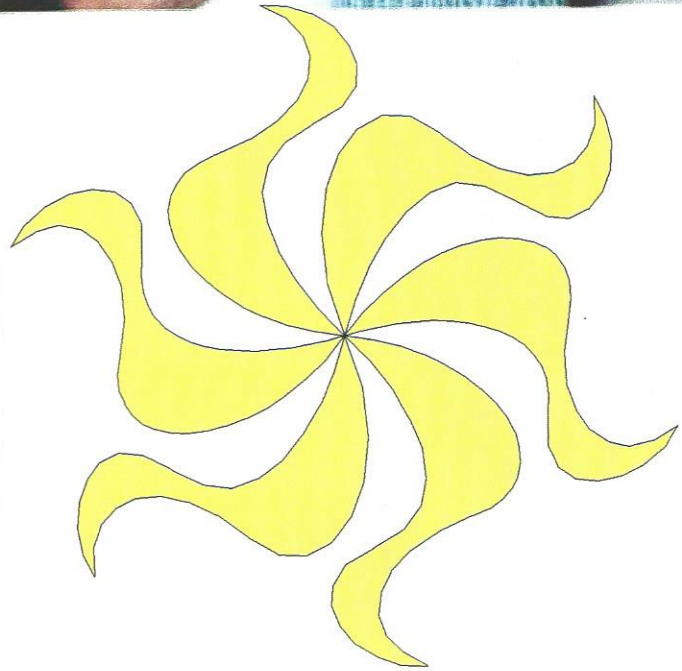
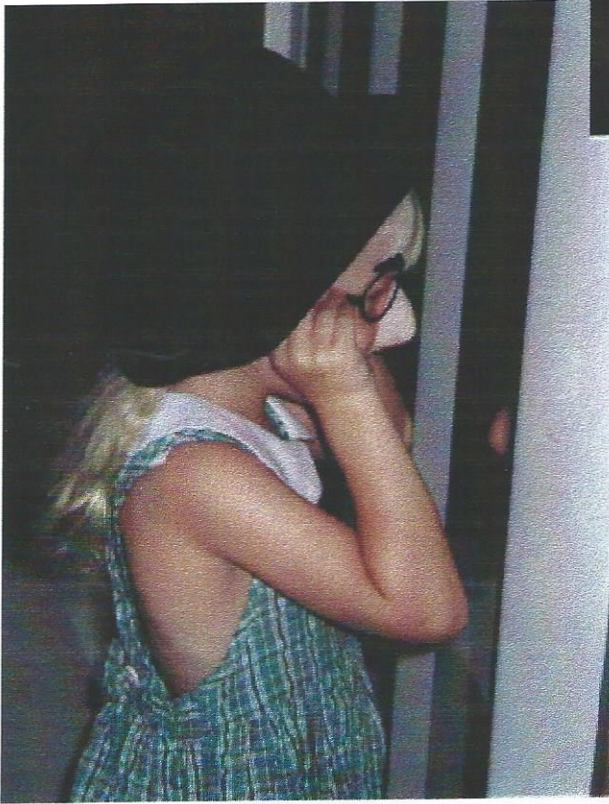
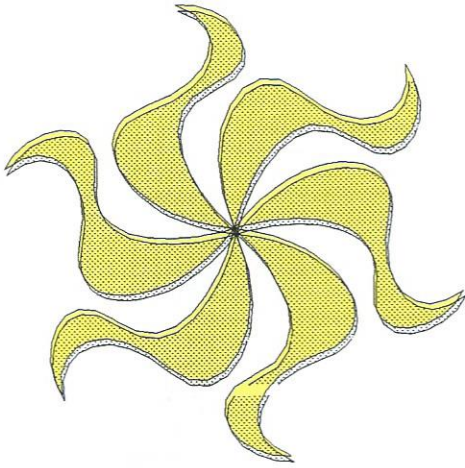
**Grandma and Grandpa meet us

I can dress up as a bride



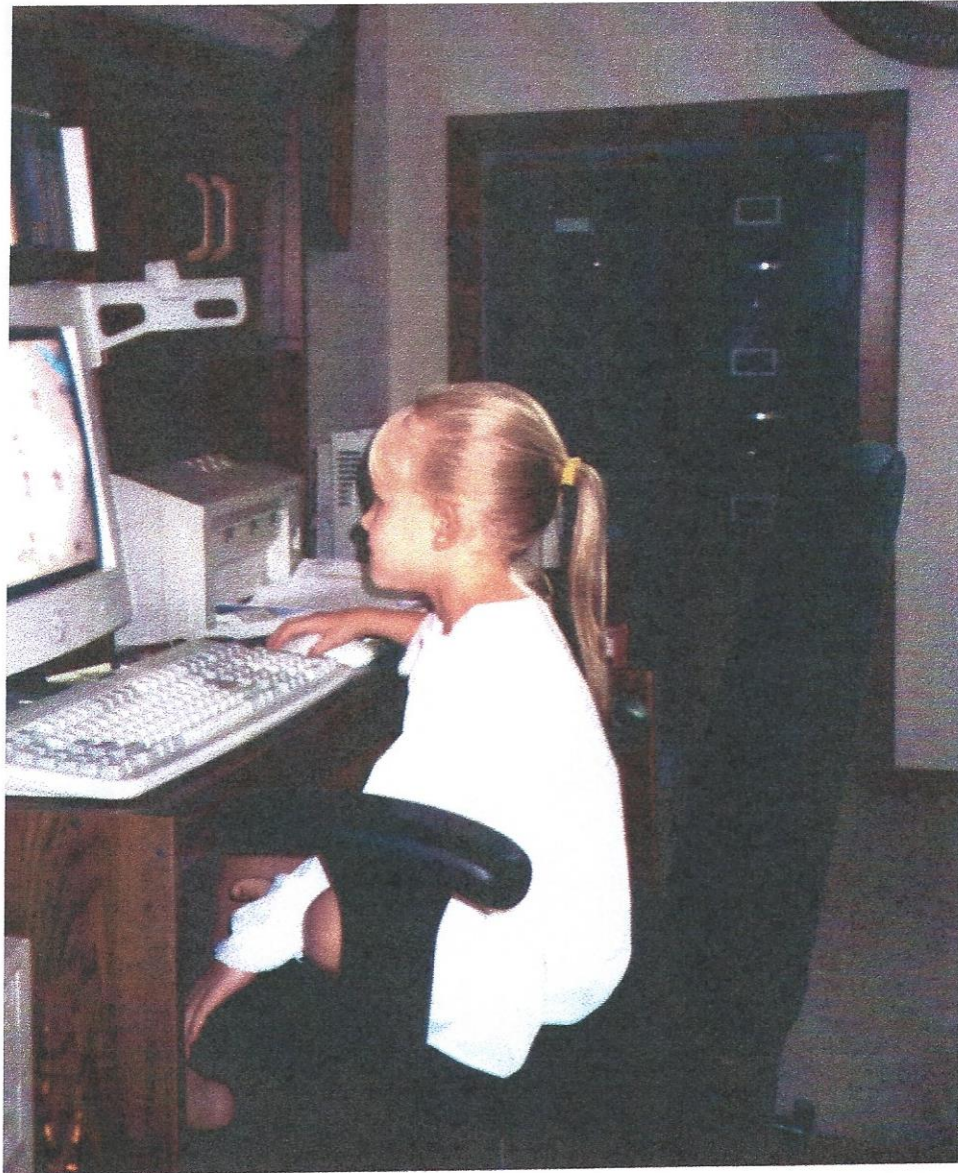
Or, I can pretend to be Queen Esther from the Bible.



Grandma and I love to dress up in fancy old-time hats and beads and have a tea party.



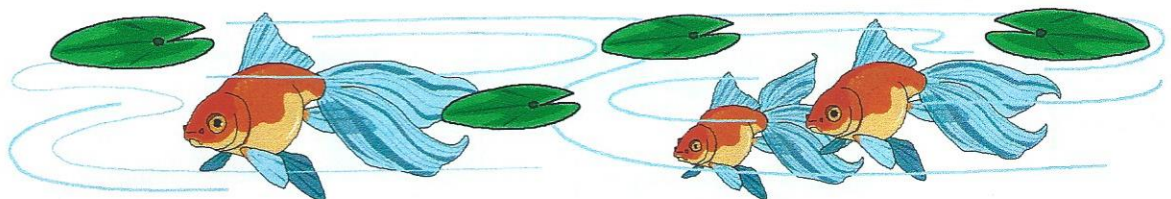
I love Grandma's tea parties!

Grandpa's computer

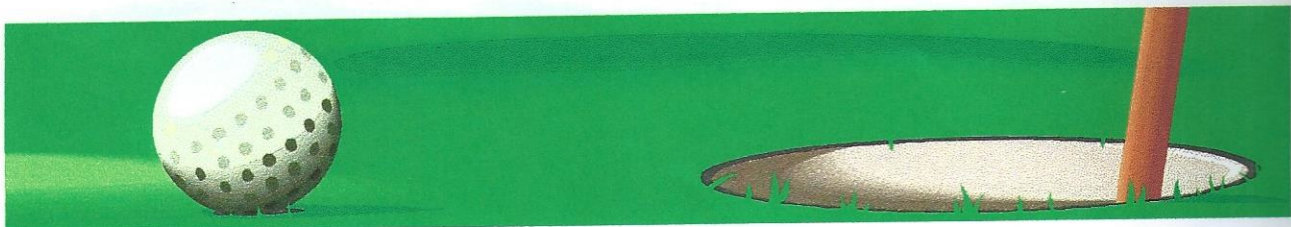


We go to the park near Grandma's house.



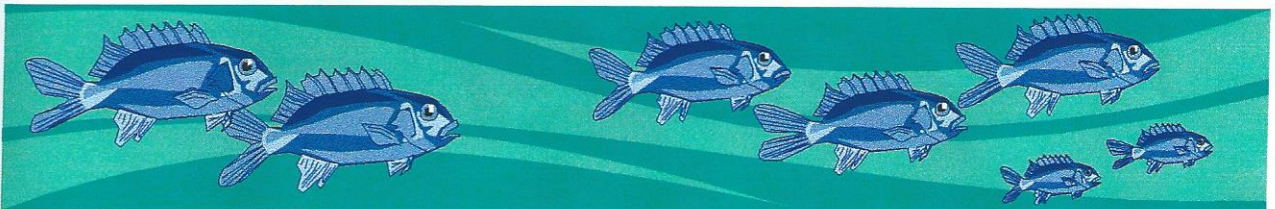


We hit a bucket of balls at the practice range on the golf course.





What fun to cool off in the wading pool!

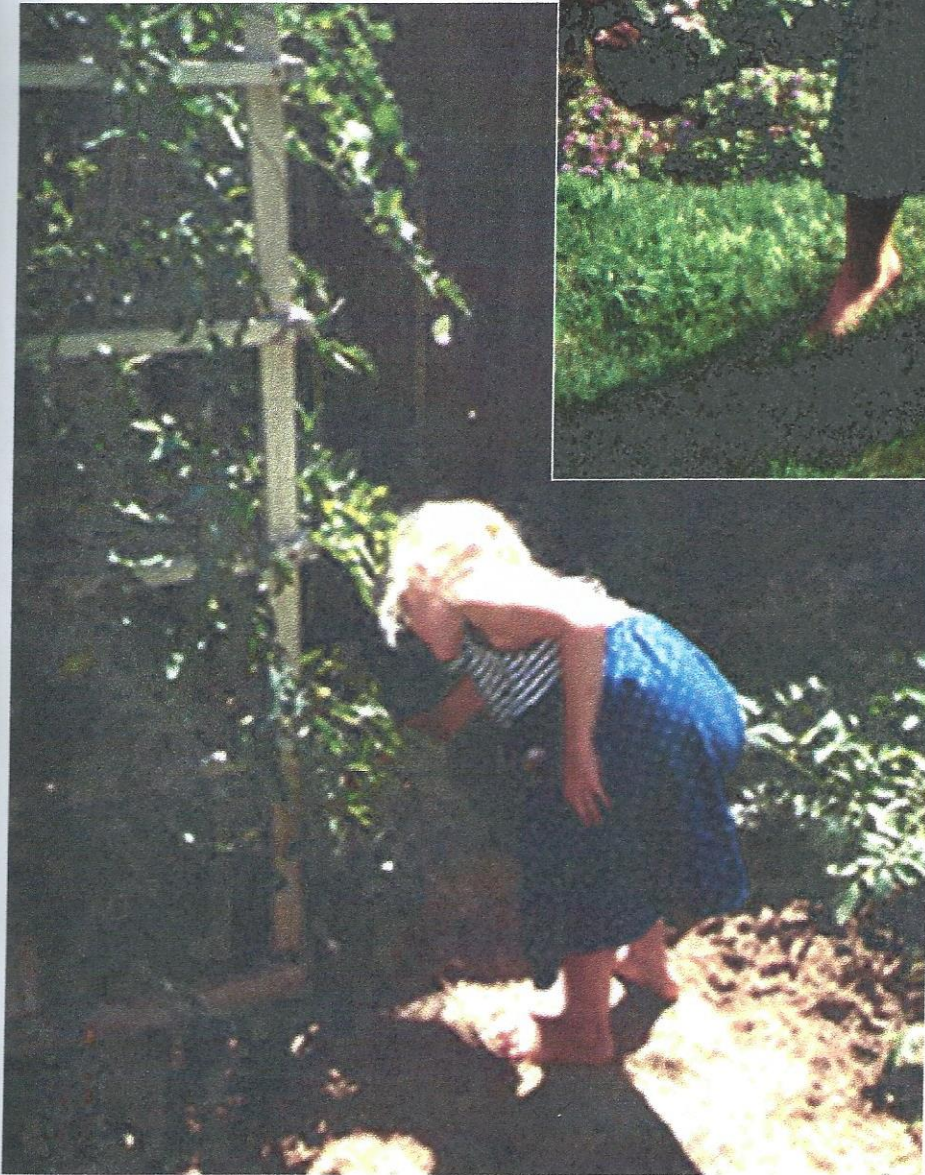





Grandma shows me how to use her binoculars to watch the birds take a bath, or the little rabbit nibble grass in her yard.
